She learns a new one every two years. To many people, this seems impossible. However, Lýdia says she is not particularly intelligent, and she believes anyone can learn a new language. Through her own experience and from meeting other successful learners, she has found out some helpful methods.
2. Lýdia believes that there are many different ways to learn a language. You can study common words, practise grammar, use phrase books or listen to podcasts. Almost any method is fine - the most important thing is that

you enjoy the learning process. For example, when learning German, she watched Friends in German. At first, she did not understand anything, but over time, she could follow the story. She did something similar with Spanish, reading Harry Potter books that she had loved as a child.
